3. Workmanship – method of construction, choice and execution of stitches
4. Design – simplicity of line, harmony of color, appropriateness

#### Dressmaking:

1. Material – appropriateness, quality, color, and design
2. Design – simplicity of line, harmony of color, appropriateness
3. Workmanship – method of construction, choice and execution of stitching

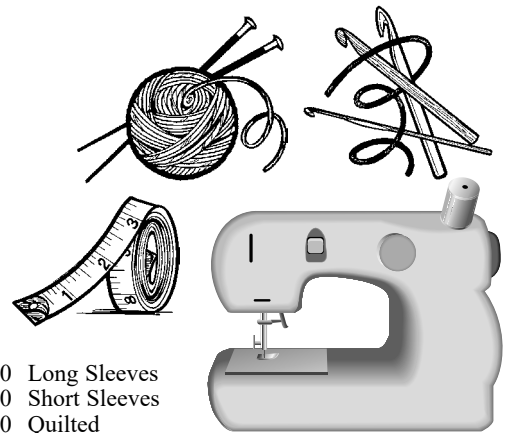
